

How to Set Up Google Pay

First, check that contactless payments are set up on your device:

1. Open the Google Wallet app.



2. At the top right, tap your profile picture or Account.



3. Select **Tap to pay setup**.

4. Check if you're ready to make contactless payments. To tap to pay with Google Wallet:

- Near-field communication (NFC) must be turned on.
- To make a tap-to-pay transaction with a card in your Google Wallet, Google Pay should be set as your default payment app.

Add Card to Google Wallet:

1. Open the Google Wallet app.



2. At the bottom, tap **Add to Wallet**.



3. Tap **Payment card**.

4. Any cards you saved to your Google Account are shown.

5. Tap **New credit or debit card**.

6. To add a card, use your camera or tap **Enter details manually**.

7. At the bottom, tap **Save**.

8. Read the Issuer Terms and tap **Accept**.

9. If you're asked to verify your payment method, choose an option from the list.

Tip: After this step, you should get a message that your card was added and is ready to make contactless payments in stores, online, or in apps where Google Pay is accepted.

NOTE: After you add a card, you might find a small transaction on your account from Google Wallet. This transaction checks that your card and account are valid. This transaction will **soon disappear** and doesn't affect your balance.
